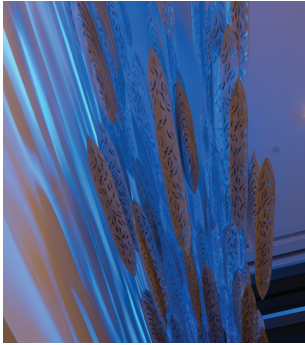

LOCATION	Narragansett, Rhode Island
DESCRIPTION	Composed of abstract forms that reference the hull of an ocean vessel or the body of a fish, <i>Schooling</i> takes inspiration from its orientation in the Graduate School of Oceanography's main atrium space opposite Narragansett Bay. Comprised of four separate forms, the sculpture's layered forms repeat and aggregate into a wedge-like massing of more than two hundred individual sculptures evoking the schooling habits of fish.
