Title Chinese Pillow Fountain Plaza

Location Moffett Towers, Sunnyvale, California

Description Chinese Pillow Fountain Plaza is one of six entry plazas that act as gathering points for social interaction along the main pathway at the 52-acre Moffett Towers Corporate Campus in Sunnyvale, CA. This plaza features a circular composition of grasses, trees, a granite recycled water fountain and varied geometric block seating. In this LEED Platinum recycled water flows through the quilted pattern grooves of the granite fountain into a circular basin filled with smooth river rock to create a subtle and relaxing sound. Like an outdoor room, the plaza helps extend the workplace to the outside and encourages users to stay on premise throughout the workday.
